(a) Cancellation by Insurer.

(i) If the insurer cancels the insurance policy for nonpayment of premium, [When the cancellation is initiated by the insurer,] the Notice of Cancellation shall be filed at least 10 days before the effective date of the cancellation, in compliance with § 19-406(f) of the Insurance Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

(ii) If the insurer cancels the insurance policy for any other reason, the Notice of Cancellation shall be filed at least 30 days before the effective date of the cancellation, in compliance with §19-406(a) of the Insurance Article, Annotated Code of Maryland. [as required under Article 48A, §482H, Annotated Code of Maryland]

(iii) [A Notice of Cancellation received by] *If* the Commission designee *receives the Notice of Cancellation* less than *the required number of days* [30 days] before the effective date *of cancellation* set forth in the notice, *the Commission* shall [be amended by the Commission] *amend the notice* to provide [an] *a new cancellation* effective date *by adding 10 days or 30 days, as applicable, to* [of cancellation 30 days after] the date of receipt.
